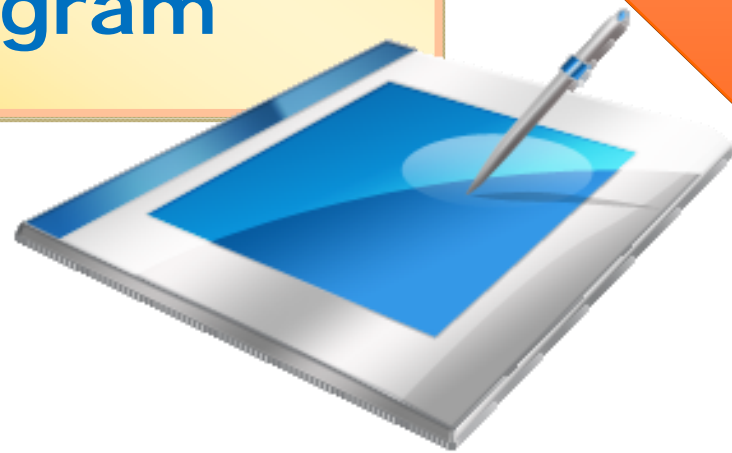

VECTOR GRAPHICS

Adobe Illustrator is the industry standard for creating vector graphics/illustrations. It has an extensive tool kit but it also a huge learning curve! This course teaches you the fundamentals of using the program through a series of projects. Vector graphics are used for creating Logos, Signs, Posters as well as any other graphics which require large degrees of scaling— an example of this is a logo which will fit on a business card but can also be scaled up to fit on a billboard with no loss in clarity. This is where vector graphics excels.
